Except for the below District rules, we will follow All Official rules and regulations set by Little League Baseball.

Local Rules:

AA

- No New Inning after 1:30 minutes of playing time. Playing Time will commence right after the "Plate Meeting"
- Max 5 Runs can be scored in the half-inning by the offense.
- The last inning will be declared un-capped runs. Meaning, the offense can score as many runs as possible until 3 outs are recorded, or the team goes through the batting order once. The Game's Umpire-In-Chief will declare the last inning and inform both managers. There is a possibility that a game may not have an un-capped runs inning depending on the time.
- Runners may advance only on Pass Balls. A Pass Ball is any pitch not properly handled by the catcher.
- 3rd Base will be locked. If a runner has not reached 3rd Base before any fielder makes a throw on a batted ball, the runner cannot advance home. A throw is when the ball leaves the hand of the fielder.
- Runners must be batted or walked home. No advancing to Home Plate on Pass Ball.
- No Mercy Rule in effect
- Championship Game will be a full 4 innings with the 4th inning being un-capped innings

Please Note: Players may not leave the dugout, except to use the bathroom. No one may approach the dugout to speak to the manager, coaches or players. Max 4 adults in the dugout (Manager, 2 coaches and Health Official). Ensure all adults are in the dugout when on offense and not lingering outside the dugout's entrance from the field.

AAA

- No New Inning after 1:45 minutes of playing time. Playing Time will commence right after the "Plate Meeting"
- Max 5 Runs can be scored in the half-inning by the offense.
- The last inning will be declared un-capped runs. Meaning, the offense can score as many runs as possible until 3 outs are recorded, or the team goes through the batting order once. The Game's Umpire-In-Chief will declare the last inning and inform both managers. There is a possibility that a game may not have an un-capped runs inning depending on the time.
- No Mercy Rule in effect
- Championship Game will be a full 6 innings, with the 6th inning being un-capped runs

Max 4 adults in the dugout (Manager, 2 coaches and Health Official). Ensure all adults are in the dugout when on offense and not lingering outside the dugout's entrance from the field.

Majors

- No New Inning after 2:00 hours of playing time. Playing Time will commence right after the "Plate Meeting"
- 15 and 10 Run Mercy Rules in effect
- Courtesy Runner for Catcher and Pitcher with 2 outs
- Championship Game will be a full 6 innings

Max 4 adults in the dugout (Manager, 2 coaches and Health Official). Ensure all adults are in the dugout when on offense and not lingering outside the dugout's entrance from the field.

Intermediate (50/70)

- No New Inning after 2:00 hours of playing time. Playing Time will commence right after the "Plate Meeting"
- 15 and 10 Run Mercy Rules in effect
- Courtesy Runner for Catcher only with 2 outs Championship Game will be a full 7 innings

- No New Inning after 2:15 minutes of playing time. Playing Time will commence right after the "Plate Meeting"
- 15 and 10 Run Mercy Rules in effect
- Courtesy Runner for Catcher only with 2 outs Championship Game will be a full 7 innings
